Located in Co. Donegal, Loughderryduff Wind Farm is operational within the townland of Loughderryduff. The site is located approximately 6km west of the village of Glenties. Planning permission for this site was granted by Donegal County Council in 2004 and includes for 18 No. conditions. The development consists of 9 number Vestas V52 wind turbine generators and crane hardstandings for each turbine, electrical substation, underground electrical cabling, access tracks and ancillary services. This wind farm is owned and operated by Highfield Energy as part of our broader commitment to a sustainable future.
